



Help us Imagine what Buckeye will look like in 2040

Buckeye faces a number of choices as it plans for its future through the update of its General Plan. The city is projected to add over 250,000 people, 100,000 housing units and 78,000 new jobs by 2040. Although much of this growth is expected to occur in master planned communities, this growth will impact the entire city. Therefore the General Plan needs to address questions such as:

- ▶ Where should the growth be targeted?
- ▶ Should the city allow higher-density housing and if so where?
- ▶ How does the city provide police and fire services?
- ▶ What type of commercial and employment uses should we attract?
- ▶ How do we make our community sustainable?
- ▶ Should the major streets be redesigned to make them more pedestrian and bicycle friendly?
- ▶ How should we plan for public transit?

Your input is critical in making these decisions:
